

RESOLUTION
in regard to
ORDINANCE 1-1977
FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM REGULATIONS

WHEAREAS, the Supervisors of Washington Township has agreed to take such official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the Flood Insurance Program, and since there is no professional engineer on the Board of Supervisors,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Supervisors of the Township of Washington, beginning immediately upon adoption of this resolution shall do the following:

1. Require a certification from a professional engineer that any proposed construction in a flood zone area will be built in conformity with the regulations of the National Flood Insurance Program, that all public utilities and facilities, such as sewer, gas, electrical and water systems are located, elevated, and constructed to minimize or eliminate flood damage, that adequate drainage is provided so as to reduce exposure to flood hazards and, that the required new or replaced water supply systems and/or sanitary sewage systems ~~to~~ are designed to minimize or eliminate infiltration of flood waters into the systems and discharges from the systems into flood waters, and the on site waste disposal systems are located so as to avoid impairment of them or contamination from them during flooding.

2. All costs resulting from securing a certification from a professional engineer are to be paid by person or persons requesting a Building Permit.
